The Pediatric network (DanPedMed) was established in 2016 through a collaboration between the Danish Pediatric Society and the Danish Society of Clinical Pharmacology working for better medicine used in children and adolescents. It is today a professional research network of pediatricians, clinical pharmacologists and other stakeholders who are working for better medicine used in children and adolescents.

DanPedMed is also member of a European network conect4children https://conect4children.org/

The network involves all Departments of Paediatrics and Adolescent Medicine as well as Departments of Child and Adolescent Psychiatric in Denmark. DanPedMed has direct contact to clinicians working within both fields

Pediatrics in Denmark

Somatic treatment of children and adolescents in Denmark takes place at general practices, at private clinics that are specialized in children and adolescents and in hospitals. In Denmark there are 18 Departments of Pediatrics and Adolescents medicine and DanPedMed has access to approximately 160 clinicians in various pediatric sub-specialities.

Numbers

In Denmark the total Pediatric Population is: 1.155.838 (19.5 % of total) (2023)

- 0-2 years: 186.792
- 3-5 years :187.161
- 6-12 years: 466.971
- 13-18 years: 343.201

Pediatric vaccination is voluntary and covers a range of vaccinations (https://en.ssi.dk/vaccination, 2019)

Neonatal screening is carried out to diagnose 18 different conditions: (https://nyfoedte.ssi.dk/information-in-other-languages, 2023) e.g. Sickle cell disease, Cystic Congenital hypothyroidism, Phenylketonuria (PKU), Medium-chain fibrosis, acyl-CoA dehydrogenase deficiency (MCADD), Maple syrup urine disease (MSUD), Isovaleric acidaemia (IVA), Glutaric aciduria type 1 (GA1), Propionacidemia (PA)
